A grilled chicken breast on a bed of garlic-herb linguini topped with sun-dried tomato pesto & fresh parmesan cheese.

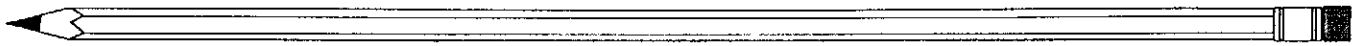
